Are You a Fan of Savings? Fans are your friends. Ceiling fans are great for moving cool air around the room and creating a nice breeze in the summer. If you raise your thermostat by only 2° F and run your ceiling fan counterclockwise, you can lower your air conditioning costs by up to 14%. Setting your ceiling fan to turn counterclockwise also allows air to circulate downward, maintaining a breeze indoors. Remember, ceiling fans cool you, not the room. So be sure to turn them off when you leave the room.
